- 1. Uphill riders have the right of way. Downhill riders yield to uphill riders.
- 2. Wear a helmet.
- 3. Carry in, carry out. Leave no trace. Respect wildlife.
- 4. Ride only open trails; observe, respect and obey all signage.
- 5. Stop at all road crossings, slow down at intersections.
- 6. Ensure water crossings are safe.
- 7. Stay in control at all times. Pass with care.
- 8. Share the trail. Yield to pedestrians and other trail users.
- 9. Many dirt roads are within working forests. Please watch out for and yield to logging trucks.
- 10. Many of our trails are remote, plan ahead, ensure equipment is working properly and you have spare parts and basic tools.
- 11. Don't count on cell phones. Please let someone know where you are going and when you plan to be back. Ride in groups if possible.
- 12. Always ride with food and plenty of water.

Emergency Information

- 1. In the event of a medical emergency, first attempt to use a cell phone to call 911.
- 2. If riding in a group of three or more, have at least one person stay with the injured person.
- 3. Mark the location of the injured person on a map, and if possible use a GPS to get a coordinate.
- 4. DO NOT attempt to move the injured person if a head, neck or back injury is suspected.
- 5. Attempt to keep the injured person warm and dry.
- 6. Assist the injured person to the nearest road if the injury is not to the head, neck or back.
